Programs will provide additional opportunities for information, learning, community engagement and enrichment.

The Library does not allow programming that is solely for commercial, religious or political purposes. Library sponsorship of a program does not constitute an endorsement of the content of the program or views expressed at the program.

The Library may partner with other agencies and organizations to present programs. Any sale of products such as books or CDs at the Library programs must be approved by the Library and benefit the Library or the co-sponsoring group. No solicitation of products or services is permitted.

The Library Director is responsible for programming. The Library welcomes opinions from patrons regarding programming. If a patron has a concern or question with a program, they should communicate with the Library Director in person or in writing.
