### COVID-19 Update

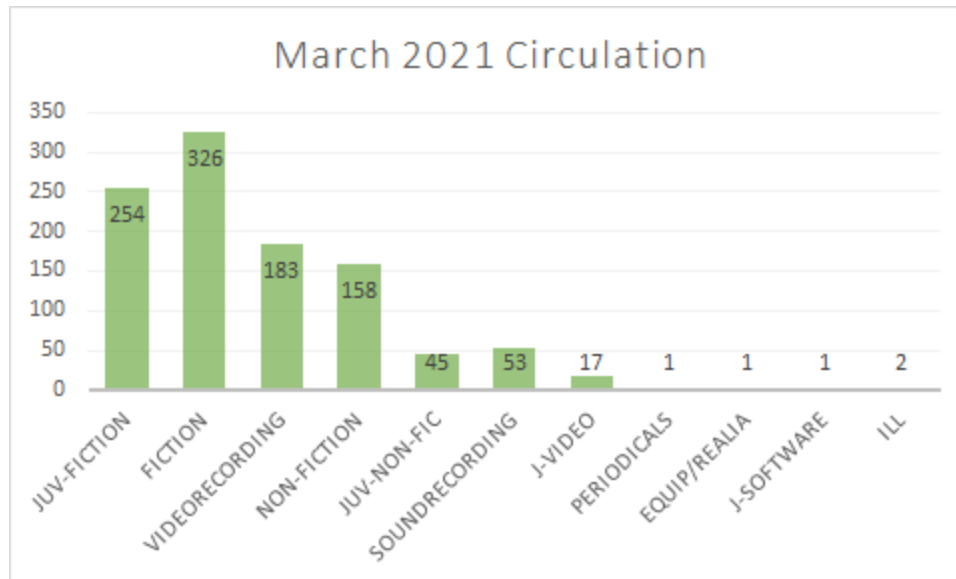
- Executive Order 202.98 has extended the Open Meetings Law adjustments to **April 20<sup>th</sup>**.

- 2020 Annual Appeal total as of 4/9/21: \$21,669.00

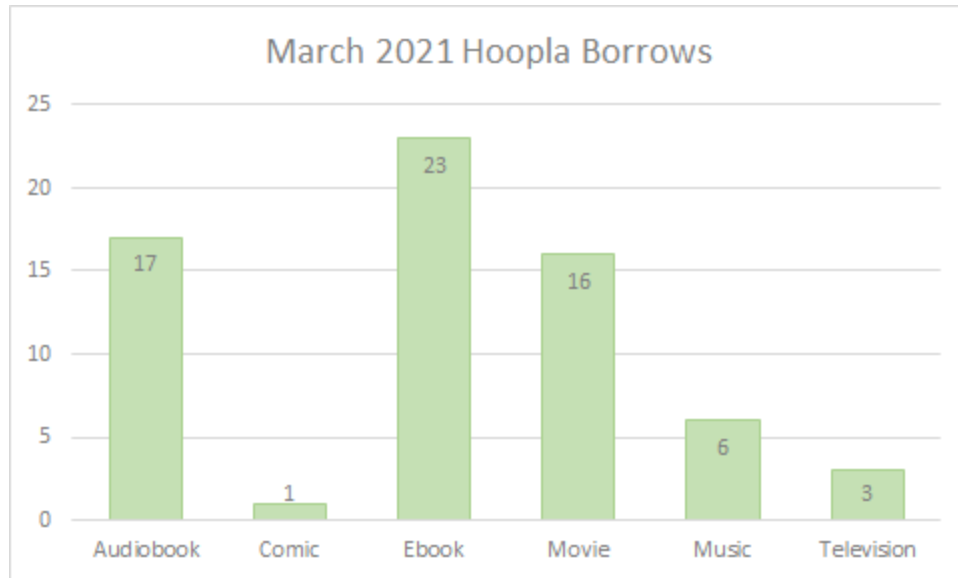
