Minutes of Meeting – April 26, 2021

The Friends met via Zoom on Monday, April 26, 2021, at 4:30 pm. There were eleven people in attendance, including Carol Bancroft and three library trustees.

Carol and Kim Lewis reviewed the status of the book sale, which is scheduled for June 11-13 (with a brief “dealers’ night” on June 10). There will be special sections, including gardening and railroad history. A sign-up sheet will be circulated in two weeks. Other tasks that may require assistance include distributing flyers (next week), folding and taping a print newsletter (mid-May), moving the books upstairs (a week before the sale) and boxing unsold books after the sale. Carol is exploring the possibility of accepting credit cards. A plant sale will coincide with the book sale, and plant donors were asked to notify Carol in advance.

Eliot Werner asked about other projects that may be assigned to the Friends, after the book sale. Carol suggested the Election Day raffle may be a candidate.

The Friends will meet again towards the end of May.
