Minutes of Meeting – May 24, 2021

There is no need to use the google application – volunteers can simply call the library to sign up. After the sale remaining books will be available at the library, in \$5 bags, and then remaindered to Better World Books. Masks will be required inside the building. The group discussed the efforts to publicize the event, and Eliot Werner suggested providing the information to Carol Mackin for distribution.
