Funding/Fundraising

- Received: \$1,290.54 LLSA Payment, representing 90%. The remaining 10% will arrive later in the year (or early next year).
- LPC Update: New shelving has been ordered. Estimated delivery in October. We will likely need help disassembling the old shelves and assembling the new shelving. We also need to consider what should be done with the old shelving. One possibility is using some of it in the Activity/"Teen" Room downstairs as supplemental shelving.
