Minutes of Meeting – August 22, 2022

The Friends met on Monday, August 22, 2022, at 4 pm, at Town Hall. There were five people in attendance. Nancy Drago, Friends Chairperson, led the meeting.

Carol Bancroft described the work of the Budget Proposition Committee. The Committee is meeting today at 5:30 by zoom, in person on September 12, and weekly thereafter (see attached schedule). Sign-up sheets for volunteers will follow.

Nancy described the plan for Clinton Community Day (September 3), the first in sixteen years. There will be separate tables for the library (with rock painting, information and library cards) and the Friends (in conjunction with the Budget Proposition Committee), offering information on the budget, along with totes and directories. A sign-up sheet is attached.

Carol outlined the needs for the Election Day raffle. Set-up will begin October 28. In the meantime the Friends are encouraged to begin soliciting donations from local businesses (see attached to sign up).

Barbara Burns reported that the Highway Department is raffling a truckload of firewood at Community Day, and suggested the Library consider offering an exciting gift, such as tickets to a Broadway show, at the same event.

Nancy announced that the Friends will not meet in September, but will meet via zoom on October 24 and November 28, both at 4 pm.
